This bird show is open to all bird amateur breeders who are in order
in regard to the species of bird they breed.

Location of the show : salle de l'Espace d'Ornon – 33140 Villenave d'Ornon (suburb of Bordeaux)

Take exit number 18 on the motorway (rocade). The exhibit hall is on the road to Léognan.

Program :

- ❖ **Registration (for the bird contest and bird sale) : before October 5 2009.** Please use the registration forms from UOF-COM France or those you may download from the AOG Internet site <http://www.aogirondine.fr> and send inscriptions charges at the same time you mail your registration form. Fill a separate form for colour canaries, a form for posture canaries, a form for the exotic birds straight beak, and a separate form for parrots and a separate form for hybrids and European fauna. - ❖ The AOG reserves the right to close registrations when it has reached its enrollment capacity.
- ❖ Birds will be put in cages Friday October 16 2009 from 8H to 19H.
- ❖ Judging in the presence of breeders Saturday October 17 2009 from 8H30 to 16H.
- ❖ Inauguration: Saturday October 17 at 19H.
- ❖ Open to the public: Sunday October 18 from 9H to 17H.
- ❖ Award ceremony: Sunday October 18 at 11H.
- ❖ Birds removed from their cages Sunday October 18 beginning at 18H.

Please note : no contest for song canaries nor quails or colins.

- ❖ The classifications are those of the UOF-COM France (classification 2009-2014).
- ❖ The judges will decide between the birds and give them an overall score, there is no score card, the catalogue will indicate the score and the ranking. The top 5 birds (or stams) will be listed provided they have obtained the minimum necessary score of 90 (individual) or 360 (stams). The judges decisions will be final.
- ❖ The judges will be able to comment about the judging immediately or at the end of the judging. Breeders are allowed to attend the judging but must not in any way interfere or slow the process of the judging. A breeder not exhibiting birds may attend the judging provided he has paid the Saturday entrance fee.
- ❖ At the end of the afternoon and Sunday morning breeders will be able to talk with the judges.

Awards :

- ❖ The top 5 birds of each class will be rewarded. The rewards are not cumulative.

- ❖ A general classification to the number of birds who placed will be established. Each champion will bring 5 points, each second place brings 4 points, each 3rd place brings 3 points, each 4th place brings 2 points and each fifth place brings 1 point. The awards and cups will be displayed on a table. Breeders will be called in the order of their rank and will choose the prize they want. If they cannot be present they must designate someone who will choose for them.
- ❖ A rank by specialty has also been established = breeders prize with the points total on 7 birds (or more in case of 2 breeders with the same amount of points) : lipochrome canaries, classic melamine canaries, melamine mutations canaries, posture canaries with smooth feathers, posture canaries with curly feathers, domesticated exotic birds, non domesticated exotic birds, budgies and lovebirds, other parrots, European fauna and hybrids.

- ❖ Each breeder who enrolls more than 30 birds in the contest will receive a surprise gift.

Rules and veterinary formalities :

- ❖ Only birds with conformed closed bands with the breeder stamp or his affiliated club information will be permitted to participate and justifications will be requested on band 00.
- ❖ French breeders will be requested to furnish a “certificat sanitaire global” delivered by the D.S.V. of their department that states that the birds do not have infectious diseases. Without it the birds will not be accepted.
- ❖ Foreign breeders will have to provide the necessary veterinary documents for a bird exhibit abroad.
- ❖ The organization A.O.G. and the veterinary surgeon have the right to refuse any bird about which they have doubts.
- ❖ For the species that require a capacity certificate, the breeders will have to provide said certificate copy and an authorization to transport the birds.
- ❖ The European fauna birds breeders must have the authorization to breed from the originating country.
- ❖ The registration fee for the bird show is 4 euros per bird. For posture canaries that do not go in cardboard show cage, the breeder may show in his own cage provided they conform to the breed, in that case the registration fee is only 1 euro 50 per bird.
- ❖ Each breeder will be required to pay a mandatory cancellation insurance fee of 0.30 euro per bird entered in the contest or the sale area . If the contest was to be cancelled the A.O.G. would reimburse the breeders of all their registration costs for contest or sale area birds.
- ❖ A registered bird may be replaced by another bird in the same class. In case of absence of one or more birds the registration fees will not be reimbursed.
- ❖ During the time the birds are in cages the breeders will have to provide enough water and seeds to their birds for 48 hours. The organization will not be held responsible for the death or possible theft of birds.
- ❖ If need be it may be possible for the efficient and harmonious running of the show that participants are asked by the organizers for their help.
- ❖ Unless previously indicated by a breeder, during registration, breeders mailing address, phone number, e-mail address will be listed in the catalogue.
- ❖ A breeder or exhibitor promise to respect the A.O.G. rules and regulations and authorize the A.O.G. to make use of pictures of him/her or his/her birds taken during pictures or movies made during this 2009 contest.

Bird sale area :

- ❖ A free bird sale area is included during the bird show.
- ❖ Only registered contest participants can sell birds..
- ❖ The birds for sale must be from their breeding stock and banded. They will be placed at a maximum of 2 per cage. The cages must be large enough for the birds. The breeders must provide food and water for the birds.
- ❖ Price of the birds are set by the breeders no percentage will be taken by the show organizers.
- ❖ The A.O.G. is not responsible in case of misunderstandings between breeders.
- ❖ A register for breeders participating in the sale area will be established all breeders participating will have to fill the register.
- ❖ The sale area participants will have to accept the area assigned to them.
- ❖ As they register, breeders in the sale area will have to indicate how many birds they intend to bring to sell and if they will be in cages or crates. If a breeder needs cages from the organizers, he must state, when registering how many he will need.
- ❖ An admission fee will be required 2 euros per bird. If cages are needed it is an additional 3 euros per cage. All these fees are to be paid at the time of registration.

- ❖ It is possible to reserve a sale space for a flat fee (contact JP Glemet)
All happenings not thought of in the rules and regulations will be cleared and handled by the A.O.G committee.

Convoying

- ❖ Grouping and convoying of the birds are possible, The list and names of the the conveyors will be on the internet site <http://www.aogirondine.fr>
- ❖ A conveyor bringing 200 contest birds or more will have his room and board paid for by the organisation (2 nights and 4 meals offered).

Meals and accommodations:

- ❖ Meals may be eaten at the site. Meals must be booked at the time of the registration.
- ❖ Hot meals for Friday night (17 euros).
- ❖ Lump sum for Saturday's day time activities = entry to judging + coffee + 2 drinks + cold meal of Saturday noon (23 euros)
- ❖ Banquet Saturday evening with conference of Mr Abellan and Mr Grimalt (Spain) about the Jaspe Canary (30 euros).
- ❖ It is possible to take part in the Saturday activities and the Banquet even if one doesn't exhibit bird. One only needs to register in advance and pay the appropriate fees.
- ❖ Hot meal of Sunday noon (17 euros).
- ❖ The rooms accommodations are provided by 2 hotels who have partnered with our exposition they are situated in Villenave d'Ornon hotel zone motor way exit 17 Hotel Stars (Phone 05 56 37 90 00 Fax 05 56 04 05 86) or Hotel Altica (Phone 05 56 04 64 64 fax 05 56 04 64 65).
